


Why was an Exodus necessary?

"And there arose a new king who had not known Joseph." Ex 1:8.






Moses's Mothers

- · Jocebed (the Lord is Glory)
- Also Moses's Great Aunt (Ex 6:20)
- Obeyed Pharoah laid basket in reeds in the Nile. Miriam stayed to watch
- This part of the story is mostly feminine working with Elohim not Yahweh
- Pharoah's daughter: Jubilees 47:5 and Josephus both name her as *Thermouthis*, the Greek name of the Egyptian *Renenūtet*, goddess of nourishment and the harvest, and depicted as having a cobra's head
- 'When she opened it, she saw the child, and the boy was crying. And she had pity on him and said, "This is one of the Hebrews' children.'








A clear Soul can ride on the waters of Yezirah Because it is inspired (air-filled) from Beriah.





Serpents and Creation

- Hopi: Snake Youth (a Sky spirit) and Snake Girl (an Underworld spirit).
- Ouroboros, the Greek symbol of eternity, was a snake curled into a circle, biting its own tail.
- In Egypt, Apopis, serpent demon of chaos attacked Ra, the sun god each night. But Mehen, another huge serpent, coiled himself around Ra's sun boat to protect him.
- The Aboriginal people of northern Australia tell how the Great Rainbow Snake, Julunggul, shaped the world.
- Diegueño Indians of California: The serpent Umaihulhlya-wit lived in the ocean until people called him onto the land. They set him on fire. The serpent's body exploded, showering the earth with the knowledge, secrets, songs, and other cultural treasures he had contained.





Jormungand, that which encircles the world in Norse Mythology.

Three Signs of Power

- Staff to serpent
- Leprous hand
- Water from Nile into blood on land


